Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Scholarship recipients must attend an accredited college or university with tuition requirements in the academic year following their selection. Scholarship funds will not be paid directly to the award recipient. Scholarship funds may be applied toward tuition, fees, or book purchases and other appropriate educational expenses, as determined by the Scott E. Monk Scholarship Fund Committee.

Public Relations & Publications

The Scott E. Monk Scholarship Fund recipients will be promoted via internal and external print and social media channels. Recipients should allow AtlantiCare and the scholarship committee to promote their receipt of this award.

Eligibility

Applicants are limited to AtlantiCare employees and their dependents who are currently pursuing a career in the medical or nursing field. Applicants must be enrolled in a qualifying 2 or 4 year degree program or have completed the prerequisites at an accredited college or university and are in good academic standing.

Required Supporting Documents

5 " Enrollment Verification: Verification of enrollment is required.

6 " Transcripts: In addition to proof of enrollment, please provide a copy of transcript(s).

7 " Essay & Statement of Need: Please include a short essay describing why you should be selected for this scholarship based on the following criteria:

1. How your work impacts the medical community;
2. How you have gone above and beyond for a patient and their family;
3. Why you are in need of scholarship support to pursue your academic interests

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Please submit any documents that attest to the community service or volunteer work in which the applicant has been involved. Please feel free to submit copies of any awards, certificates, or commendations that may have been received in reference to volunteer work.

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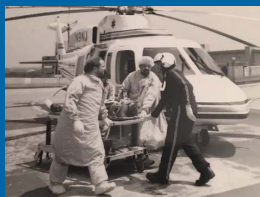
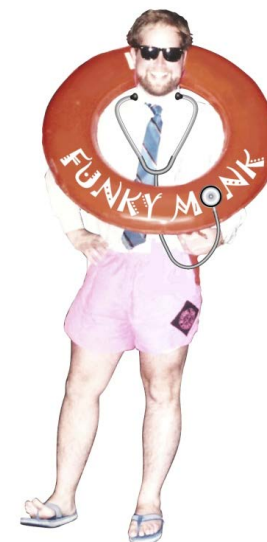
The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from non-family members with the completed scholarship application.

Funding Information

Four awards of \$5,000 each will be issued to eligible individuals who are pursuing a medical or nursing degree.
